The building services design aims at deserving a high reliability in order to achieve a deluxe environment, in term of air conditioning, lighting and vertical transportation.

The purpose of this visit is to provide an opportunity for young members to have better ideas about the design and construction of the Electrical and Mechanical Installation for Modern Retail Complex. It will include a guided tour with focus on the major plant rooms and pioneering building services systems, environmental and technology features of the building services installation.
