Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting for the CIBSE Hong Kong Branch 2010 / 2011 session was held on 8 March 2011 at World Trade Centre Club of Hong Kong with the presence of 45 CIBSE members. Chairman of the Hong Kong Branch of the 2010/2011 session, Dr T M Chung, presented his Chairman Report and he also gave his gratitude to the committee members and the YEN for their support and accomplishment in the past 12 months. It was followed by the Financial Report for the year of 2010 presented by the Honorary Treasurer, Mr. K Y Leung. The reports were accepted by the Meeting.

Hunan - Hong Kong Joint Symposium 2011

To facilitate experience sharing and to promote development on building services engineering between the Mainland and Hong Kong SAR, CIBSE-HKB, HKIE-BSD and ASHRAE-HKC have jointly organized symposiums in Liaoning, Tianjin, Beijing, Shanghai, Nanjing, Xi'an, Chongqing, Qingdao, Shenyang, Wuhan and Chengdu over the

past years. This year, coorganised with the Department of Building Services Engineering of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, the 3 institutions jointly organize a 2-day symposium with professional bodies in ChangSha of Hunan, China on 1 & 2 July 2011. The theme of the symposium is "Green & Sustainable

Technology Development". Speakers from academic and design institutions as well as experienced professionals are invited. Those interested may visit our website for further details of this event.

Hong Kong Branch Sponsored Research

CIBSE HK Branch conducts joint researches with local and mainland universities on topics of interests to local members. The deliverables are intended to provide useful reference to members. Research reports are posted in the local web-sites as well as targeting for publication in the CIBSE Journal.

The first research on thermal comfort was conducted jointly with the City University of Hong

Kong and the Dongguan University of Technology. A number of technical presentations had been conducted to disseminate the research findings to members. The final report was completed in 2009 and members can access the document in the HK Branch web-site.

The current researches include studies on "City Ventilation" and "Green Roof". Both studies were

conducted jointly with the University of Hong Kong. The final reports of the studies will be available in Mid-2011. We are planning future researches on LED lighting and vertical greening. These researches will hopefully commence in Mid-2011.

Energy Audit Course

The forthcoming execution of the Mandatory Implementation of Building Energy Code legislation which includes requirement of existing buildings to undergo energy audit, has increased the demand for building energy auditing capability of local building services engineering professionals. CIBSE Headquarters in conjunction with CIBSE Hong Kong Branch has organised this course with the intention to serve this purpose of contributing to establishment of building energy

auditing professional resource for execution of the legislation. CIBSE HQ has played a major role in providing technical advice to the UK government in the establishment of similar legislation in UK and in the subsequent training for building services professionals to carry out energy audit. This course, with support from CIBSE headquarters in providing course material and specialist speakers from the UK, and being complemented with experienced local speakers, should be a valuable opportunity for

professionally qualified building services engineers to supplement knowledge in energy auditing. The first course has been held on 15-16 April in Polytechnic University with John Armstrong (Ex-President of CIBSE) and Ir Professor Anthony Chi Man Sung from CIBSE HQ delivering the course. There was encouragingly active discussion amongst the forum of 27 participants and speakers and CIBSE HKB representatives. CIBSE HKB will continue to deliver this course.

Ethan Poon, the Vice-Chairman of YEN, attended the CIBSE National Conference “One Building A Minute – The Great Refurbishment Challenge” which was held on 7th April 2011 at London. The conference programme has been put together to focus on one of the most important challenges facing the building services industry in UK; that of refurbishing the existing building stock to reduce carbon emissions. An average of one building every minute will need to be refurbished between now and 2050 to meet the UK’s national targets for carbon emissions reduction. This conference enabled the delegates to understand the value propositions which will appeal to clients, will help them to cost and

win tenders with the minimum risk and will explain where to gain knowledge about strategies to achieve real energy saving for clients.

After attending the CIBSE National Conference Ethan headed to Edinburgh from London for the CIBSE YEN Conference. The conference was scheduled on 9th April 2011 (Saturday) which divided into two sessions namely the morning session “Site Visit to Royal Commonwealth Pool Refurbishment Project” and the afternoon session “CIBSE YEN Chairmen Meeting”.

The afternoon meeting was hosted by CIBSE Scottish Region and held between all the YEN committees. It was chaired

by Hywel Davies who is the CIBSE Technical Director and each YEN committee has sent either one or two committee members being the chair and / or vice chair. The purpose of this meeting, for the first time, was to pull together all the YEN committees to discuss matters concerning YEN including its role within CIBSE and where the future lies. It was a unique opportunity for YEN to discuss matters with CIBSE as well as challenging things. The event has reviewed the development of YEN since its formation and explored the opportunities for further growth of the network in the next three years.
